

GUIDELINES

1. Eligibility

- i. Must be a member, in good standing, or child of a member or legal guardian in good standing with Greater Emanuel Apostolic Temple located at 1150 West Galbraith Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45231.
- ii. All applicants must be enrolled in any of the following institutions: university, college, junior college, trade/technical school; and must provide proof of enrollment by August 31, 2018.
- iii. All scholarship recipients will not be given the actual award until he/she is actually enrolled in a university, college, trade/technical school, or junior college for the 2018-2019 academic year.
- iv. Must be age 26 or under, and not in graduate college (an exception will be made for military veterans not in graduate college.)

2. Every applicant is required to submit a minimum 300 word essay on one of the following:

GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS: (select one)

1. Describe your most meaningful achievement and how it relates to your future goals.
2. If you had the authority to change your school in a positive way, what specific changes would you make?

COLLEGE APPLICANTS: (select one)

1. What do you consider to be the single most societal problem? Why?
2. Pick a controversial problem on college campuses and suggest a solution.
3. What are the most important issues your field of study is facing today?

3. Every applicant must submit at least 3 typed reference letters with your application, none may be relatives.

A church member (pastor, minister, teacher, youth leader or auxiliary head)

Academic advisor (school counselor, teacher, coach, professor, etc.)

One of your choosing

4. Scholarship applications will be available starting **February 4, 2018**. Your completed application, essay, and reference letters must be emailed by 11:59 pm April 15, 2018--only electronic (e-mailed) submissions will be accepted. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.** You must request and schedule your interview for one of the following Sunday **dates: May 6th, 20th, or 27th, 2018 by April 15, 2018.**

5. Scholarship applicants will receive an acknowledgement of receipt within ten days of the submitted application via email. Please provide a contact email address on the application to which the receipt will be mailed.

6. The decision of the scholarship committee will be final. Notification to all applicants, regardless of outcome, will be made by **June 10, 2018**.

7. All scholarship recipients must attend the GEAT Graduation Ceremony on **Sunday, June 24, 2018** during Morning Worship Service (11:15AM) or contact Pastor Daniel for a consideration waiver prior to the ceremony.

8. The Scholarship award and amount will be determined at the discretion of the GEAT Scholarship Committee.

9. All information provided will be kept confidential and used only for purposes pertaining to the GEAT Scholarship process.
